As friends over the years our memories of Sally include fun nights as sixth formers at Torquay's night clubs, Sally always being late with birthday cards but always sending them with love, Sally zipping about in her sports-car and more recently in her striking mini. And more recently still, Sally surrounded by friends creating hilarity by mishearing fairy for ferry and impishly turning up at subsequent gatherings wearing fairy wings. Sally's career for many years was as a civil servant, working for the Department for Work and Pensions, latterly focusing on tackling fraud. Her colleagues there also experienced her care and kindness, with a ready word of encouragement by the water cooler and always a funny tale of her beloved bull dogs. Sally loved to make collections including Beatrix Potter characters, and pictures of her bulldogs. Without doubt Sally's self-described most important roles were those of wife, mum and nanny. Her three sons, their partners and children were all tucked under Sally's caring wing.
