Crafted in collaboration with Birmingham Universities Hospitals Trust, these thoroughly curated 6-month medical and 4-month dental programmes provide a unique glimpse into the medical and dental fields. With the flexibility of an E-learning format, participants can navigate their placements at their own pace, exploring vital topics like ethics, procedures, and broader team roles. This virtual experience not only enhances students' UCAS applications, but also strategically prepares them for the practical challenges and opportunities ahead.

Taking part in the Virtual Work Experience will provide:

- Comprehensive Insights: The programme covers a range of specialities, providing a deep understanding of medical and dental practices. Each month, a new focus area is introduced, allowing participants to delve into different aspects of the field.
- Flexible Participation: Tailored for students from years 10-13/S3-S6/NI10-14, the programme accommodates various schedules by being virtual. Participants have one month to complete each specialty, ensuring flexibility and ease of participation.
- Recognised Certification: Upon successful completion of all sessions, students will receive a certificate from Medic Mentor and UHB, validating their active participation which they can include

in their UCAS and apprenticeship applications.

This month's spotlight is on Obs & Gynaecology or Paediatric & Dental Surgery. It's a chance to get a firsthand look into the inner workings of the medical and dental fields, helping your students shape their career aspirations in their chosen path.

From Monday 7th April, a new rotation will begin for the month, changing to General Practice or Public Health & Oral Pathology.

Train the Trainer: UCAS Tools

As part of ongoing efforts to support students in making informed decisions about their future, **UCAS has a number of tools available** to support prospective students – all available to use through the [UCAS hub](#):



- **Favourites feature** – ideal in early research to keep track of favourite university and course choices.
- **What to study next?** – Students can input their current A level (or equivalent) subjects and see what other people with similar subjects applied for.
- **Personal statement builder** – breaks down what is needed for each section of the statement and provides prompts to help students get started.
- **Subject spotlights** – delivered by university lecturers, these are the perfect way for students to experience what it's like to study a subject without committing to it.
- **Industry guides** – students can discover what job roles are like in different sectors and the various pathways that can be taken to get into them.
- **UCAS hub live** – live streams and on-demand content available on numerous topics such as personal statement hacks, application guidance and shortlisting workshops.
- **Virtual work experiences** – interactive virtual work experience opportunities delivered by leading employers. A great opportunity for students to get a real taste of different careers.

- **Careers quiz** – matching personalities and careers. A great starting point for those unsure what to do next.

Historical Entry Grade Data

On each course page, **students now have access to historical entry grade data** helping them better understand their chances of being accepted onto specific courses. Students can view accepted A-level and BTEC grades from 2019–2023 across England, Wales, and Northern Ireland.

Three Key Data Points

- **Grades held by accepted students:** Shows the range of grades held by successful applicants.
- **Rate of offers for UK school leavers:** Showing how many applicants received offers.
- **How do you compare section:** Students can add their predicted grades to see their likelihood of acceptance.

We are running launch events in Reading, London, Birmingham and Cardiff plus a 5-week programme of online mentoring, before a 3-day summer school on our beautiful campus.

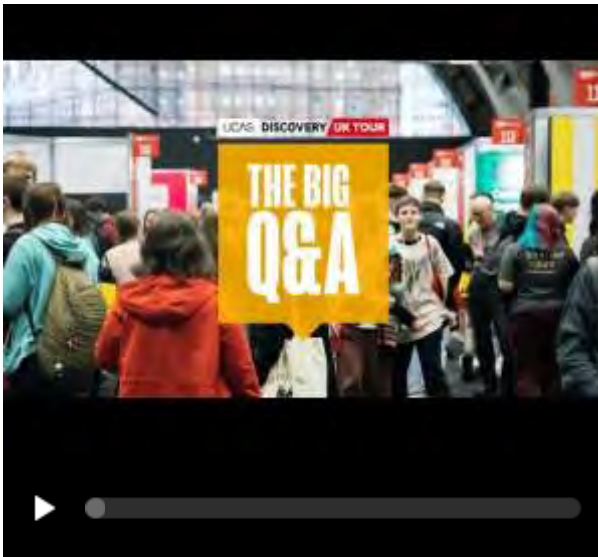

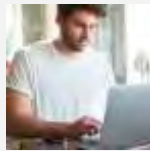

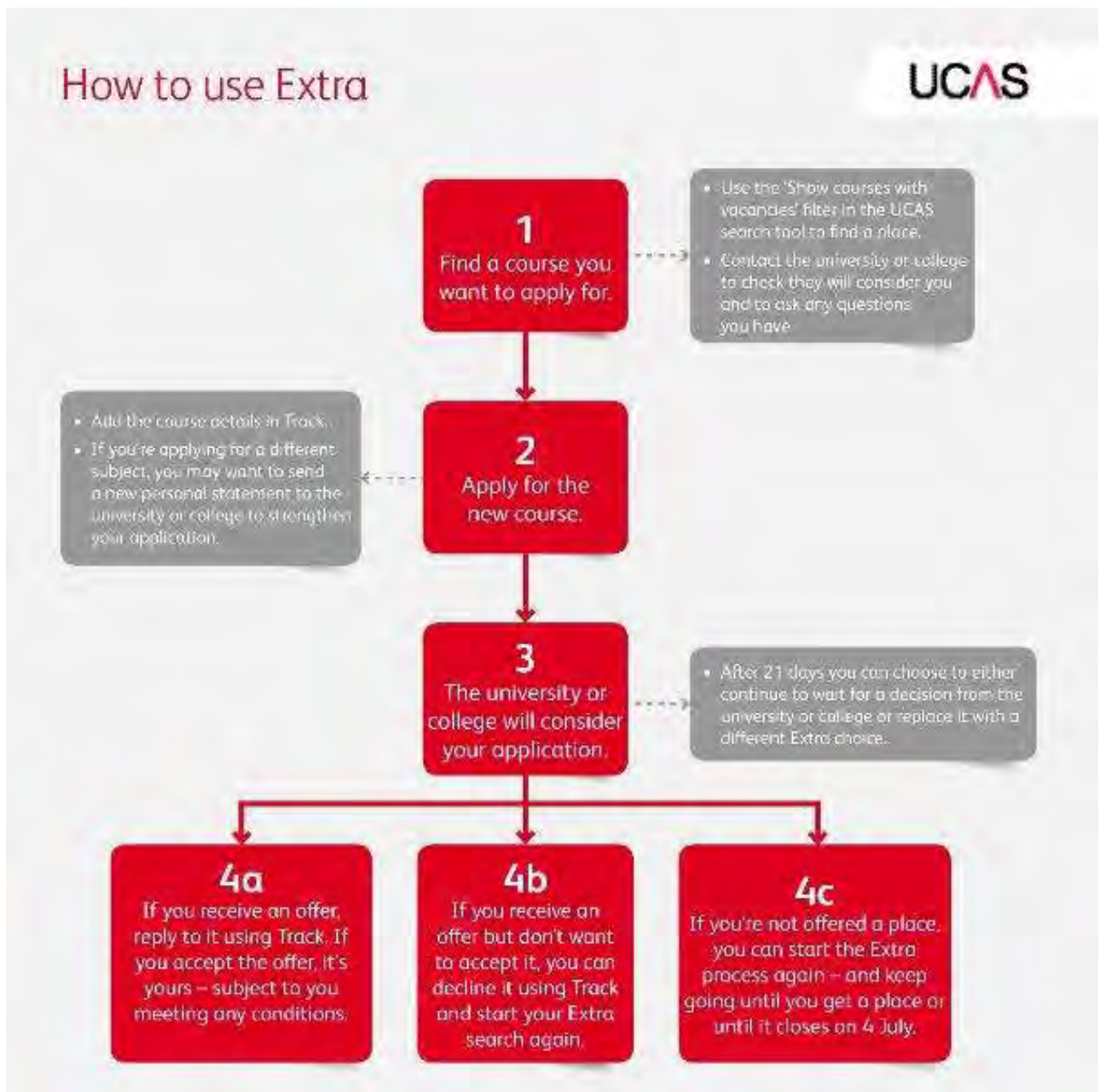
