Student Opportunity: Medical Mentoring Program

CONTEXT

The initiative provides free 1-to-1 ongoing mentoring for students aspiring to study Medicine. Our mentors are medical students and junior doctors from all over the UK wanting to give back to the communities. They all have an advanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) or Protect Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme checks carried out by their respective University or NHS trust.

Our aim is to aid aspiring medical students in their medical school applications.

We currently have over 2,400 medical students and doctors looking to help a student at your school. Last year we supported over 1,000 students by matching them to one of our mentors.

PROGRAMME OUTLINE

- This is an initiative designed to run for two years.
- The initiative will start immediately and run until mentees are successful in obtaining a place in medical school.
- Mentees are free to leave the initiative at any point.
- The expectation is to have at least 4 'virtual meetings' (1 per term). Meetings will be arranged on Zoom/MS Teams. All meetings will be recorded and stored. The school will be able to view this if requested.
- The initiative is completely free for students and schools. **No costs will ever be incurred.**

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAMME

- Allow students to have a personal mentor to encourage them in their studies towards becoming a medical student.
- Support with UCAT medical admission exams.
- Support with their personal statement, work experience and interview preparation.

New Undergraduate course - BSc Finance



The University of Bath is introducing a new course within the School of Management for September 2026.

The BSc Finance course will give students a solid grounding in all areas in business, specialising in the skills and knowledge needed for a career in finance. Students will learn the fundamentals of finance, accounting and economics. They will also further develop their mathematics and specialise in areas of finance, including vital skills like programming.

As with other University of Bath courses, students can choose the four-year course, and apply their skills in a practical business environment with a work placement. We have links with over 380 companies of all sizes, these are real jobs and usually paid.

Specialist optional units in the final year will equip students with the knowledge to pursue careers in various parts of the finance industry as well as a chance to apply what's been learned on the course to a practical or academic finance-related research question.

The typical A level offer will be A*AA/A*A*B in 3 A levels including an A* in Mathematics. The course page with further information and alternative offers will be on our website in the near future.

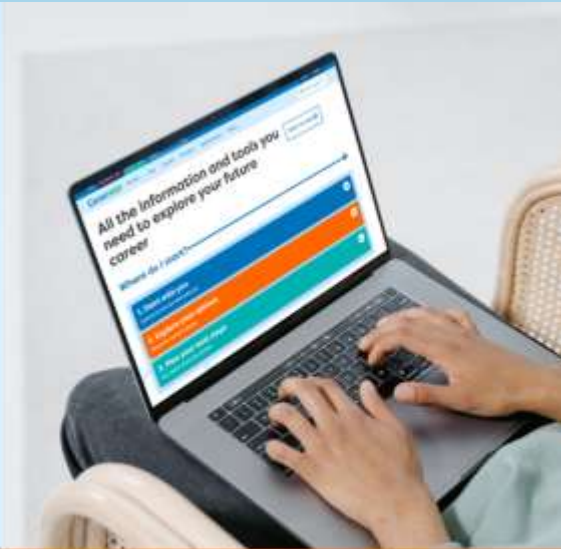

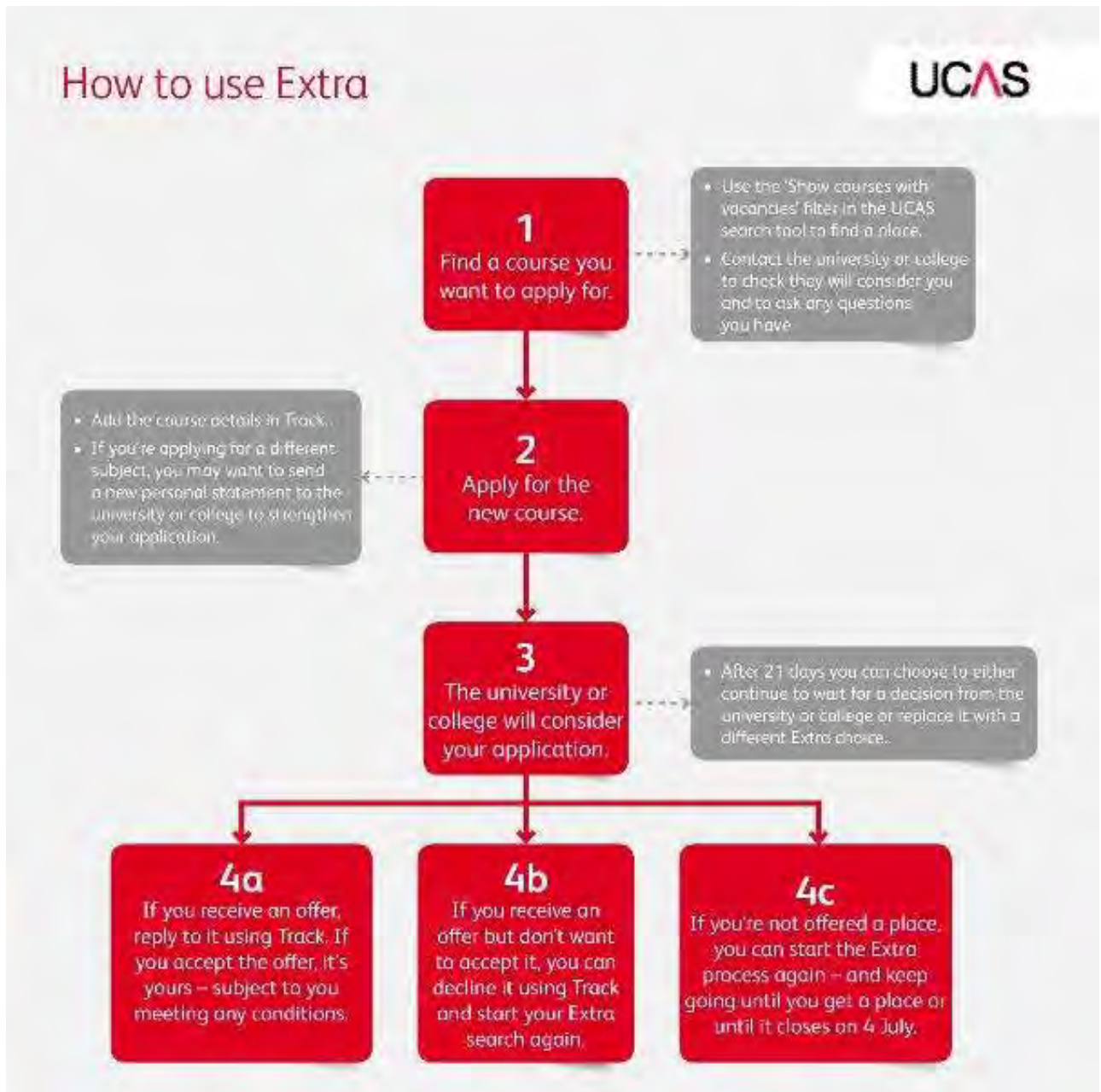
